**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON,
COUNTY OF MORRIS, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO
AMEND CHAPTER 172, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 172, Streets and Sidewalks, Article V, Street Openings, Section 172-31, Permit required, subsection B, of the Code of the Township of Washington, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“B. No opening or excavation shall be permitted within the surface of any public road, street or right-of-way under the control of the Township upon which a permanent pavement has been placed within five years of the date of the application of such pavement, except as noted in Section 172-38.”

SECTION 2. All ordinances of the Township of Washington that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
