AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AMEND CHAPTER 203, VEHICLES & TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON AND TO ESTABLISH TRAFFIC REGULATIONS FOR NORTH FOUR BRIDGES ROAD AND SOUTH FOUR BRIDGES ROAD

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 203, Vehicles and Traffic, Article IV, Control for Movement and Parking of Traffic on Public and Private Property, Section 203-30, Municipal and Board of Education Property, Subsection C, Item 5, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- “(5) Parking for the handicapped. The following locations shall be designated and reserved as handicapped parking spaces for persons who have been issued a motor vehicle identification sticker or license plate. No other person shall park a vehicle in any area assigned as a handicapped parking space, as described below. Vehicles shall be parked between the posted lines:
 - (a) Five spaces to be designated handicapped, to be located on the southerly end of the front parking lot.”

SECTION 2. No person shall park a vehicle at the designated times upon the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Hours	Location
South Four Bridges Road	East	7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.	From a point 100 feet south of the center line of County Route 625 to a point 485 feet therefrom

SECTION 3. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets:

South Four Bridges Road	East side, starting at a point 485 feet south of center line of County Route 625 southward to the Washington Township/Chester Township corporate line
South Four Bridges Road	West side, starting at a point 850 feet south of the center line of County Route 625 southward to the Washington Township/Chester Township corporate line
North Four Bridges Road	Both sides from the center line of County Route 625 (Bartley Road) northerly to a point 1,200 feet therefrom

SECTION 4. Appropriate regulatory signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above parking regulations as authorized by the NJ Department of Transportation.

SECTION 5. All ordinances of the Township of Washington that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication and as required by law and upon the posting of appropriate signs.
