**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON,  
COUNTY OF MORRIS, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO  
ESTABLISH TRAFFIC REGULATIONS FOR BARTLEY ROAD**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** No person shall stop or stand a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets:

Name of Street	Location
County Route 625 (Bartley Road)	Both sides, starting at the center line of North Four Bridges Road easterly to the Washington Township/Mount Olive Township corporate line
County Route 625 (Bartley Road)	Both sides starting at the center line of North Four Bridges Road westerly for a distance of 1,500 feet

**SECTION 3.** Appropriate regulatory signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limits as authorized by the NJ Department of Transportation.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances of the Township of Washington that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 5.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication and as required by law and upon the posting of appropriate signs and upon approval of the Commissioner of Transportation.
