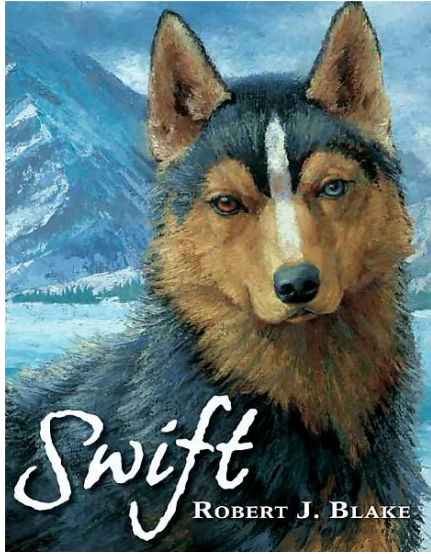


Robert J. Blake

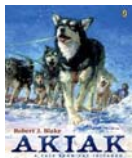
